Song Recreations

Students will study and recreate a song using music technology, developing their DAW and production skills

Program Music

Students will look at industry style briefs, and will respond to them using music production skills

KS4 Advanced Keyboard Skills

Students will develop their instrumental skills on the keyboard further, as well as progress their understanding of chords, harmony and melody

Industry Style Brief

Students will apply their skills and knowledge development in y9 to an exam style brief

Music Industry

Students will explore the roles, skills and jobs in the music industry, and will use this to respond to briefs

Logic Composition

Students will be introduced to Logic, and will use this to develop their composition skills and apply the various ways of developing musical ideas.

Songwriting

Students will study the modern methods of song writing, and will compose and perform their own original music

Film and video game music

Students will develop their understanding of how tonality and instrumentation can effect the mood of a piece, and respond to industry style briefs.

Year 8 Performance

Students will develop their historical context of blues music, and apply its key features into performances

Students will be introduced to the world of music technology and it's role in music creation. Students will create original music with these tools.
