22nd November 2021 – Thanksgiving Day (USA)



Cultural - Thanksgiving Day is a national holiday in the United States, and this year occurs on Thursday, November 25. It is predominately a North American holiday, but with over 139,000 US citizens in the UK it will also be celebrated by some here in the UK! The day is celebrated as a chance to show gratitude to those we love and marks the start of the Christmas season.



Thanksgiving Day goes back to the time when Europeans travelled over to start new lives in America.

In 1621 a group of Europeans, who became known as the 'Pilgrims', invited the local Native Americans to join them in a feast.

The Pilgrims had had trouble growing enough food to eat in the years before. The Native Americans had taught the Pilgrims how to grow crops successfully and, to thank them for this, the Pilgrims invited them to a big feast.



How do people celebrate Thanksgiving Day?

The message of Thanksgiving is about family and loved ones and being thankful for them. People will spend time with their families (it is one of the busiest days of the year for travel), eating a turkey dinner, watching TV and helping others in need. Such as volunteering at shelters.

One tradition is the 'pardoning of the turkey'. This is where the president saves one or two turkeys each year from being killed and eaten. These turkeys go off and live their lives happily on a farm. Last years pardoned turkeys where Corn and Cob. Who got to spend a night a posh hotel!
