CITIZENSHIP – Last week you would have heard about people going out to vote in the local elections on 6th May. Do you know the difference between local government and central government?

	Local government	Central government
Geographical areas	Has powers in a local area like a town, city or county.	Holds power over the whole of the United Kingdom on many issues.
Roles	Councils apply laws set by central government through Parliament. Local government deciding how local services are run.	Responsible for the security and welfare of the whole country. Sets laws and policies that apply to all of us.
Decision makers	Councillors elected by local residents make decisions following laws set by Parliament.	Decisions made by government ministers who are MPs or Lords and run government departments.

It is very important to vote in local elections as the people in power will be making decisions on all of these services provided by local councils in your area.
