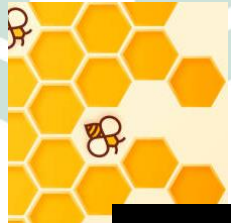

If you don't want to sing but still want to come along, sign up with one of the Heads of House letting them know you want to come give your support and be part of a great event!

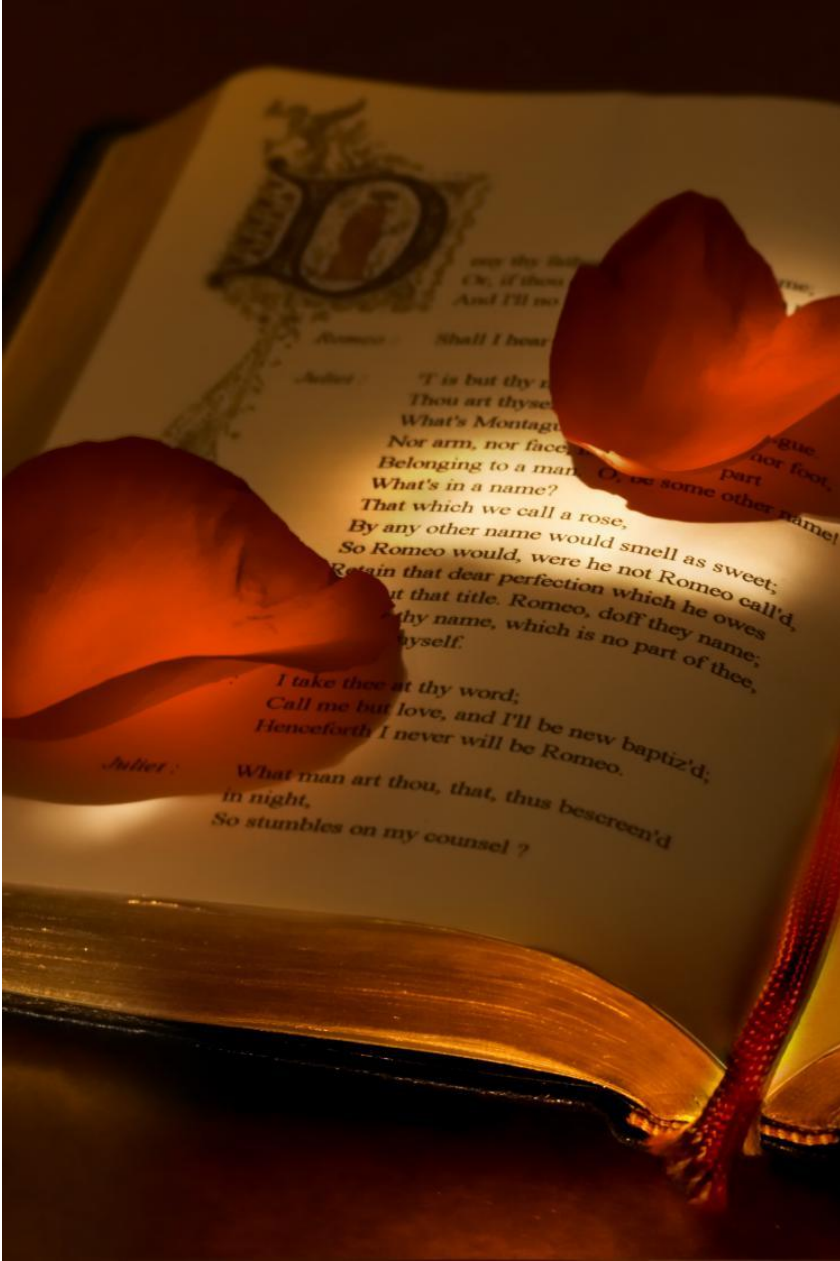

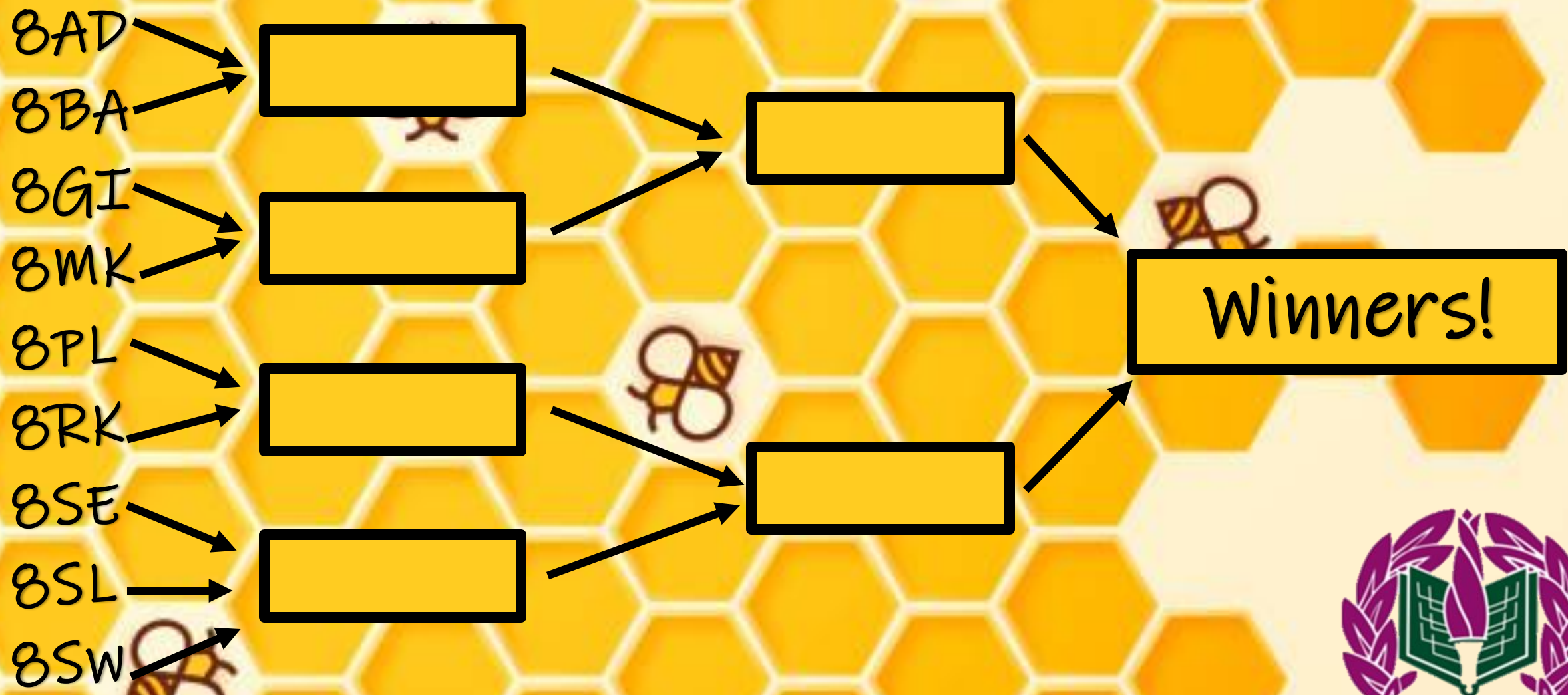
Welcome to the Year 8 Spelling Bee!

21st March 2022 – World Forestry Day



Moral – The United Nations General Assembly recognises March 21 as the International Day of Forests and utilises this day to raise awareness about the importance of forest restoration.

Trees were once treated as sacred entities but are now being destroyed in the name of urbanisation. There's no limit to how much humans take from nature without giving back. To truly value nature and understand the significance of forests, it is important to learn about the history and power this day holds.

How World Forestry Day is Celebrated
World forestry day is celebrated every year by visiting the local forests in order to learn more about their contributions towards the well-being of people. The countries which are the forest-rich (occupying almost 2/3 of the total forested area) includes Canada, the Russian Federation, Brazil, the United States, Democratic Republic of Congo, Australia, Indonesia, China, Peru, and India.
