

**Moral** - January 20 is Penguin Awareness Day. The day helps raise awareness about the flightless birds whose numbers are dwindling by the day. Penguin Awareness Day raises awareness about penguin habits and habitats.

Why is Penguin Awareness Day so important? When it comes to Penguin Awareness Day 2022, it helps bring reality into some people's life of how the world of penguins has changed over time. Penguin numbers have been dwindling around the world and the population shrinks every year, which is a part of the reason why we don't see penguins in their natural habitat.



There are 17 species of penguins, with the largest being the Emperor, that can get up to almost four feet tall, and the smallest being the blue penguin, standing at 16 inches. They have excellent vision in the water and can stay underwater for 15 to 20 minutes without coming up for air, and swim up to 22 miles per hour.


