Singers, sign up with one of the Heads of House and let them know the song you want to perform.


If you don't want to sing but still want to come along, sign up with one of the Heads of House letting them know you want to come give your support and be part of a great event!




# Welcome to the Year & Spelling Bee!

The form teams will then compete against each other in knock out rounds. The two highest scoring teams then play against each other in the final.


Each team representative will get a certificate and house points.

This is because girls "often go undiagnosed because they don't fit autism stereotypes and they mask symptoms better than boys do," according to the Child Mind Institute.
