

Being able to voice a concern, an opinion or a point of view is so important as a young adult. You now have an opportunity to voice your truth ...


We are running a session on planning and writing before your response will be submitted to Young Writers. You could have a chance to win £100, a trophy and become a published poet!





Watch on the big (or small) screen

The Lego Movie (2014) scored 96 percent "fresh" on Rotten Tomatoes, with many praising the movie's irreverent tone and colorful action. The sequel, The Lego Movie 2: The Second Part, was released 5 years later in 2019. You can also head over to YouTube and watch a Lego creator build breathtaking structures.


