Dear Parents

I am writing to let you know about the arrangements for the end of term on **Friday, December 18<sup>th</sup> 2020** and start of term in 2021

The term will end for all students at lunchtime at **12.30pm**. A packed lunch will be available for those students on FSM. Students will be able to collect a packed lunch from their break time collection point and either eat at break or when they finish at 12.30pm.

**The Academy will re-open at the normal time – 8.30 am on Monday, January 4<sup>th</sup> 2021**

May I take this opportunity to ask you to continue to support the following with your child by ensuring that he / she:

- **Has full uniform and is smartly dressed.** This means ties on correctly with two stripes and logo showing, top button fastened and shirts tucked in to trousers or skirts. Make up should be minimal. **Uniform now includes wearing the relevant identity pass at all times.** Please see the uniform poster and information on the Academy website.
- **As we remain in Tier 3 “high alert”, it is essential that all students continue to follow the Covid protocols when they return, which means:** they must come through the correct entrance for their year; masks **MUST** be worn at all times in communal areas except when eating or drinking. They should also walk on the left and abide by social distancing and non-contact with each other. It is essential that they stay in their year group zones at break and lunchtimes and leave by the nearest exit to their period 5 lesson. Full details of the protocol are on the website.
- **Please ensure you are aware of the Covid Protocols for your child and the latest advice for parents on how to access testing if you or your child develops any symptoms.** Please can I remind you that should your child test positive during the holidays **you must inform us via the Academy post box** email and include the date of their result and with a date when their symptoms started. Someone will be in touch with you before your child returns to the Academy, to ensure they isolate at home for the correct time and carry out any Track and Trace as needed. Information is available on the Academy website.
- Please can you remind your child of the importance of **regular hand washing/sanitizing** and the importance of social distancing from students or any other persons, who are not in their family bubbles.
- **Is on time for all morning tutorial periods.** This means students being in their tutor rooms by 8.35am. If you bring your child to school by car please leave plenty of time to get here on time allowing for traffic and adverse weather conditions and drop off your son/daughter at the correct entrance. When picking up your child please make sure that you park responsibly by not leaving your car near to the pedestrian crossing or on the hatched sections near to the Academy’s entry / exit gate and do not block in residents in the local areas.

- **Has essential equipment for all lessons.** This means having a pen, pencil, ruler as well as relevant books. For PE lessons students must have the correct kit, as specified in the uniform list, as well as a towel. All students should have a suitable bag in which to keep their books, planner, stationery items and PE kit / other items such as ingredients for food technology lessons in order to be ready to learn in lessons for each day.
- Please note that extra-curricular activities and period 6 have resumed since Lockdown. Please see information on the website.

Students who do not follow or meet the above Academy expectations may be subject to a range of sanctions in ensure the safety and well-being of all members of the Academy.

May I also remind you that leather jackets, hooded tops and sportswear are not appropriate and should not be worn to school? What should be worn is a proper, dark colored, warm outdoor coat, preferably waterproof for protection from the cold, rain and snow. This is particularly more important as the weather becomes colder and wetter.

Boots should only be worn when there is snow and ice on the ground, not as every day wear. Please note that trainers should not be worn in bad weather – they do not offer any more protection or grip than shoes.

Please would you ensure that your child does not have an extreme haircut or bright unnatural colored hair, this includes patterns or tram-lines (including eyebrows). Any student who fails to follow the uniform policy (as agreed by the Governing Board and available on the website), may be taught in isolation or sent home.

### **Covid Winter Grant Scheme and food over Christmas**

The recently announced winter scheme will be made available to provide children and families with extra support this winter to ensure vulnerable households do not go hungry or without essential utilities. Payments will be made to those families with children in receipt of Council Tax reduction that provides support to families on low income.

Walsall Council will make these payments direct, via bank transfer for those in receipt of this income support. Therefore, Walsall Council are not providing vouchers for Free School Meals.
