



# Joseph Leckie Academy

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, we are now reaching the end of Year 11 external examinations and, with that, the end of your child's time with us at Joseph Leckie Academy. Today, Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> June, we have released students at 12.20pm as many have finished exams for the day and students only have one or two exams left to complete, mainly tomorrow morning and on Monday morning, but there are also exams for some languages and Technology next week. Students who have the food exam this afternoon will remain on site and complete that before being released at around 2.45pm.

From today onwards, Year 11 students should only attend the Academy for their examinations and for the coursework and revision sessions that they are timetabled to attend. At all other times, they should leave the Academy site and can return home. We have had a quick assembly with students this morning and reminded them of the following things:

- **All students have to be in the Academy, and on time, for any remaining exams.** This starts with Chemistry GCSE tomorrow morning and Physics on Monday morning. Students must be in the Academy for 8.45am, ready for a 9am start. If the exam is an afternoon examination, students need to be in for 12.45pm for a 1pm start.
- Students can leave at the end of exams/coursework/revision sessions, but **must sign out** through **main reception**. If not required in for a revision session or exam, they should leave the site unless staying, supervised, in a classroom with a teacher by prior arrangement.
- **Next week; week beginning Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June, there are few exams – Physics on Monday for all students, Spanish for a small number of students on Tuesday and Technology on Wednesday.** If your child takes these subjects, they need to ensure that they attend these exams. If they do not attend an examination, then you will achieve a demand for payment for their entry for this exam.
- When not in a revision or coursework lesson/exam, students need to **leave straight away and not hang around the Academy site.**
- **Students must wear full Academy uniform when on the Academy site at all times and follow Academy behaviour rules, just as at any other time.**
- **Students still have revision lessons** available for Physics on Friday p3 and 4, for any who would like to attend and for Technology next week, if desired.
- Students who need extra support and would like to come in for revision during normal class sessions can do so, but only by prior arrangement with their teacher.

All students are to attend the Academy tomorrow, at 8.45am, as usual to attend their Chemistry exam. The 64 students who have a Food exam this afternoon will remain in the Academy.
