Dear Parent/Carers,

RE: Phased return to school from 8th March

As you are aware from my letter last week and the national announcements, we are phasing the return of students in line with Government advice. Rapid testing is one of the strategies to help keep everyone safe and Public Health England and the Department for Education are asking all schools and parents to support in these measures. Whilst testing is voluntary, **the Government strongly encourages everyone to participate in this programme to help break the transmission.**

Testing will commence by year group as stated below and if you have consented then your child will return on the date stated on the reverse for testing. This is a phased return to enable us to test safely and students will return for some face-to-face education following their first negative test result. Those who have consented to testing will come into schools on the dates stated in this letter and remain in school in lessons for that day and then return on **Test 2** day for face-to-face teaching. If, however they test positive, we will notify parents and they will be sent home and you will need to contact the NHS for a PCR test.

Once we have had all parental consents in, specific times for students to return will be sent via email to students, these times will also be available on the website. Please do complete the consent form as soon as possible. If for any reason you cannot access the online consent form and need to use the form provided, please do try and get this to us by the end of the week (Friday 5th March) so we can pre-register your child where possible. If not possible there will be a different time slot for students who need to register on the day.

Test 1 appointment times for their first test will be based on tutor groups on the stated day see the reverse of this letter. **It is important your child attends at the correct time (sent by email to them later this week)**. For the first test, students should arrive at **the Academy Reception** and line up outside and maintain social distancing and then they will be registered and issued with their bar code and then complete the test. Once they have been tested, they will go to class and remain in school for the remainder of the day. **They will then return to school on the day of Test 2.**

Test 2 (see specific year group days on reverse) students who are having their second test will arrive through their usual entrances at the normal Academy start time (8.30am to 8.40am) and go to their tutor group and they will be released from class at a stated time for their second test.

Vulnerable students and Key worker students will continue to attend as they have been doing throughout Lockdown. Those that have consented to testing, will from Monday, come in through their usual year group entrance and go to forms and lessons as per their normal Academy timetable. Those that have not consented to testing, will be in Room 11. Parents/carers of these students will be informed of these arrangements.

All students will resume full teaching in line with our phased return arrangements on 15th March.

All students who are at home whilst waiting to be tested or those not testing will receive on-line learning. This will consist of activities sent via emails from their teachers, but during this time this will not necessarily be live Teams lessons. However, students should be available at normal timetable times to work through the work that has been set by staff.

After the initial programme of three tests in school, students will be provided with two rapid tests to use each week at home. Having done these in school first, they should then be able to complete these at home. Instructions will be given once your child has had the three tests.
