This intervention is in conjunction with the arrival of the Knife Angel in Walsall and the #LifeOrKnife campaign. Therefore, the following intervention will take place in partnership with One Palfrey Big Local and Liverpool Royal Court theatre group to showcase the Terriers production.

The Terriers play -Eve's story will highlight the risks of crime, knife crime, exploitation, peer pressure and a lot more. It is a thought-provoking drama performance.
