Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Strike Action – Partial Academy Closure, Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May

On Thursday 27th April 2023 and Tuesday 2nd May 2023, union members have voted for teachers to strike across the whole country. Due to the uncertainty of how this will directly impact the Academy on the day, the following arrangements have been made:

- Years 11, 12 and 13 should come into the academy for lessons as normal. The majority of their lessons should take place as normal and where staff are unavailable, students will work in the extra study centre or in ICT classrooms where they will be supervised.
- All other year groups (Y7-10) will be asked to remain at home and complete tasks from our **Academy SharePoint site**, following the pattern of their usual Thursday/Tuesday timetable.
- Students from Y7-10 who are classed as vulnerable or who have an Education Health and Care
 Plan (EHCP) and students whose parents are critical workers should attend the academy as
 normal and enter via main Reception. These students will be based in the academy library and
 rooms in KWB2 building. To notify us that you are a critical worker and your child will need
 to be in school on the above dates, please complete the form which can be found here:
