Please join us and improve your knowledge of the law around SEND so you feel more confident in discussions and understanding decisions.

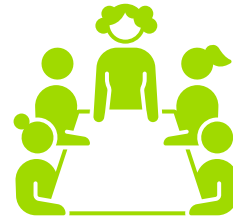

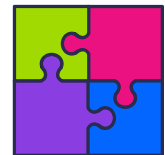


February Half Term Short breaks

The Local Offer website has recently been updated. The Local Offer provides information about help available for children and young people (aged 0–25) with special educational needs and disabilities in Walsall.

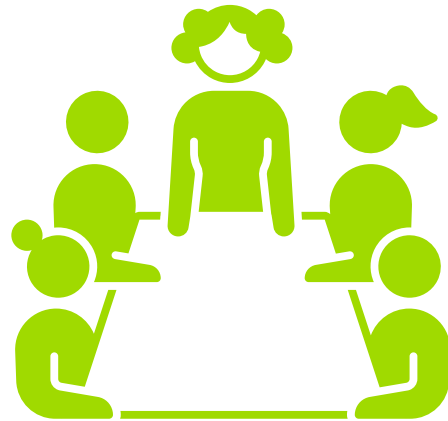

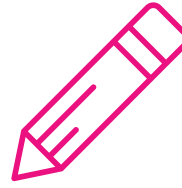
