They will also study French literary texts (novels) and / or films on which they will write an essay for their writing assessment.

Assessment

This course is linear and will be assessed at the end of Year 13. Examinations focus around the four skills of Reading / Listening and translations (50%)/ Writing (20%) / Speaking (30%).
